The Championships are open to all current Hemel Club Members, Hemel Ski Centre Instructors and invited racers. The competition consists of 3 timed runs through the same slalom course – best 2 runs to count – to determine Hemel's male and female Champion Skiers 2006 in all age groups and Champion Instructor. All Racers MUST wear a ski race helmet during racing and open practice. All Ski poles must be fitted with bungs as per SSE ruling, please complete the "Race Entry Form" and return to the race secretary by 18<sup>th</sup> September 2006. Snow and Rock once again will sponsor the overall winner of age groups CH2 and below, female and male. The award will consist of 2 pair of junior skis or 1 pair of adult skis, boots, poles and protective equipment to the value of £200.00.

### Start order:
